

Dynamix Team Competition Fees 2024-2025

The competition fee information is below. There will be two payments made this year for our regular competition season. Please note that this payment does not include states and regionals. Those payments will be collected in late winter/early spring if your gymnast qualifies for those competitions.

The first regular season competition fees payment must be made by **cash or check** on **October 18th**. The second payment will be made by **cash or check** on **November 15th** and will take into account money raised from our gift card raffle fundraiser. The gift card drawing will be held on November 9th and we will let you know how much was raised and how much will be owed on November 15th. It is expected all families participate in the fall fundraiser to help all of our families fund this season.

Copper 2 & Bronze: Total competition fees: \$640

Starstruck Invitational, Make A Wish Invitational, Crystal Springs Frozen Invitational, Powerhouse Classic
October 18th payment of \$320 and November 15th payment of \$320 (minus fundraising credits).

Diamond, Silver, Gold: Total competition fees: \$795

Be Fierce Invitational, Starstruck Invitational, Make A Wish Invitational, Crystal Springs Frozen Invitational, Powerhouse Classic
October 18th payment of \$397.50 and November 15th payment of \$397.50 (minus fundraising credits).

If your check/cash are not received by October 18th your payment will be automatically processed through the credit card on file with a \$15 processing fee (to cover credit card fees) on October 21st.

If your check/cash are not received by November 15th your payment will be automatically processed through the credit card on file with a \$15 processing fee (to cover credit card fees) on November 18th.

IMPORTANT! Missed Competitions: If you know ahead of time you won't make one of these meets, **please email Kim** at kim@dynamixgymnastics.com right away with the name of your gymnast, her level, and the name of the meet your gymnast will not be able to attend. Please note that the gymnasts need to compete in three (3) meets to participate in states. *Once meet fees are paid, those fees are out of our possession and not able to be refunded.* If we know ahead of time that your gymnast won't be able to compete in one of these competitions, the entry fee portion of that competition will be rolled over to the state meet (if payment has not been made to the host gym). Payments for the first 2 competitions are sent to host gyms prior to November 1st. The rest of the competition payments are sent to the host gyms in early December.

COMPETITION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Please note that there is no pro-rating of meet fees even if you notify us in advance of not making a meet. No matter what the reason (vacation, injury, illness, family emergency), if a gymnast misses a competition, we are unable to refund competitive fees. The reason for this is that entry fees (both individual and team) once paid are no longer in our possession and fees for coach's reimbursement have been figured out at the beginning of the season and split evenly among all the gymnasts on the team.

Practices the week of a meet are mandatory. If practices the week of a meet are missed, it will be at the discretion of the coaches as to whether the gymnast competes.

Home Meet: All team families will be required to participate in working at the home meet in some capacity and contribute to the concessions/hospitality tables for your gymnast to compete. No entry fees are collected for the PHC.

Specific days/times of meets aren't given to us for many meets until the week or so before the meet. We understand that this is inconvenient (for all of us) and will notify you as soon as we are told the schedule. DO NOT call a host gym on your own to gather this information. They will notify us that you contacted them and they won't be happy about it.
